

PLUMBING

I. WHEN IS A PLUMBING PERMIT REQUIRED?

Permits are required for all new and all replacement fixtures, drains, vents, water systems, sanitary sewer taps and drain line, stormwater sewer tap and drain line, and water service lines.

II. WHAT REGULATIONS MUST I MEET?

All work performed must be in accordance with Chapter 1105 of the Cincinnati Building Code and the Ohio Plumbing Code.

III. WHO CAN PERFORM PLUMBING WORK?

All plumbing work shall be done by a Registered Plumbing Contractor, licensed Journeyman Plumber or a registered Apprentice Plumber.

Exception: The owner of a single-family residence may do the plumbing work in his/her home provided he/she is the owner doing the work him/her self and will live in this single-family home for at least one year after completion. An affidavit confirming this is required prior to the issuance of the plumbing permit.

IV. HOW DO I OBTAIN A PERMIT?

If your work is being done by a Registered Plumbing Contractor he/she will be responsible for obtaining all plumbing permits.

If you are doing the work yourself (as described in Item III) you may apply for your plumbing permit at the Permit Center at 805 Central Avenue, Suite 500.

V. INSPECTIONS REQUIRED (24-hour minimum notice)
