

COMPLETE STREETS 2025

The Department of Transportation and Engineering is committed to building a transportation network that enables people of all ages and abilities to safely and comfortably move around the city using all modes of travel. The following Complete Street features were completed in calendar year 2025.

- .35 miles of new bike facilities
- 94,823 square feet of new/repared/widened sidewalk and 34 curb ramp installations
- 129 traffic-calming improvements
- 917 safety improvements
- 389 comfort enhancements
