- Restaurants and grocery stores
- Composting facilities
- Mobile and temporary food service operations
- Household sewage systems

ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRAMS

FOOD SAFETY

- Restaurant and grocery stores inspections
- Foodborne illness investigations
- Mobile and temporary food service operations
- Vending machines

HEALTHY HOMES/ NUISANCE COMPLAINTS

- Defective plumbing, mold, no heat
- Unsanitary living conditions, insects, and rodents
- Schools and institutional facilities
- Smoking complaints

TECHNICAL SERVICES

- Swimming pools/spas
- Vector control - rabies/animal bite complaints
- Household sewage systems
- Sewer baiting
- Mosquitoes and stagnant water

LEAD PROGRAM

- Housing lead paint removal and inspections
- Child blood-lead screening
