SAFETY FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES



- Don't cross in front of a moving streetcar.
- People using wheelchairs and other mobility devices should cross the tracks at a right angle. Be careful - wheels can get caught in the track gap.



- Stop and look - streetcars are very quiet... cross only at designated crosswalks with signals.

When the streetcar begins operating in September 2016:

- Streetcars offer 100% low-floor boarding (the first in the nation) so everyone, including people using wheelchairs and other mobility devices, can board without a ramp or other assistance.
- Wheelchairs and other mobility devices don't require securement on the streetcar. For your safety, please use the designated area and set your brake.
- Streetcars have designated priority seating for seniors and people with disabilities.
